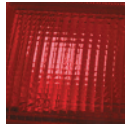

# Peace of mind

## Why do I need to make various checks on my car in between services?

Every time you use your car it doesn't just use fuel, it also consumes other liquids or causes wear and tear to certain parts. And with extended service intervals on modern cars, checking those items has become an expected part of the vehicle owner's responsibility.

Without making these checks you may inadvertently cause damage to your car's engine or even endanger the safety of yourself, your passengers and other road users – and with some of these items liable to penalty points on your driving licence or a fine, it's worth keeping them in check.

## So what are these checks?

**Tyres:** are arguably your car's most important safety feature. They are the sole point of contact between your car and the road. Tyres should be checked for tread depth and correct pressure. Just one tyre below the legal depth tread is liable to a maximum fine of £2,500 and will increase stopping distances, especially on a wet roads.



**Lights:** for legal as well as safety reasons, you must ensure that all your lights – such as headlights, indicators and rear lights are functioning properly. When you're driving in the dark you want to be sure that you're seen by other road users and that your vision is not impaired by faulty lights.



**Wiper blades:** it's an obvious thing to say, but it's important to have a clear windscreen when driving. Exposure to sunlight, ozone, oil and dirt all act to cause wiper blade rubber to deteriorate. This results in wiper blade noise, juddering and poor visibility.

**Coolant:** also known as anti-freeze, is a liquid which circulates through the engine to draw off excessive heat. Ensuring that the coolant level is correct is vital, as being low on coolant is a common cause for an engine overheating.

**Brake fluid:** when your foot presses the brake pedal, the pressure is converted into hydraulic pressure. This pressure is transferred to the brakes via brake fluid. A drop in the brake fluid level in this closed system could mean a hydraulic leak and potentially impending brake failure.

**Screenwash:** dirty spray from other road users and insects need to be removed from the windscreen – so it's important that your screenwash bottle is topped up with a good quality screenwash, not simply water or diluted washing up liquid, that shifts stubborn bugs in the summer and is less likely to freeze up in the winter or block the washer jets.

**Engine oil:** most engines will consume a certain amount of oil between services. Therefore, it is important that your engine oil level is regularly checked to avoid causing damage to the engine. Checking and topping up the engine with the correct grade of oil is a simple job, but care must be taken as too much oil can be as bad as too little.

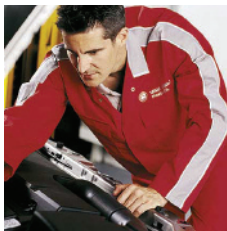
## Does everyone make these checks?

The answer to this question is almost certainly no. This is due to a number of reasons including not knowing what to check and how to make the checks or just never finding the time in today's busy lifestyles.



## What can I do to make these checks easier?

All you have to do is drop into a participating Vauxhall MasterFit retailer, with or without an appointment. For just £8, a member of the Service Department will carry out all the key checks listed. Any of the checked fluids that are found to be low will automatically be topped-up and tyre pressures will be checked and correctly set. If the checks on the wiper blades, lights or the tyres themselves reveal that further attention or replacement is required, you will be advised accordingly and a cost estimate can be provided free-of-charge.
